2. The North Craven Historical Research Group acquired a collection of Memorabilia pertaining to the late Settle Rural District Council belonging to Mr. Edwin Butt, the last Clerk to the Council.

Rita and Phil have spent many hours scanning the documents into a computer archive before depositing the material in the North Yorkshire Record Office in Northallerton.

Amongst the papers are the setting up of the Settle Union Poorhouse, people eligible for War Pensions after WW1 and the new Pension Scheme after WW2, the Harden Bridge Isolation Hospital and vaccination, various maps and plans for water

works, road widening etc. Letters of complaint from Dr. Buck; A folder of letters etc. pertaining to a railway from Hellifield to Wigglesworth that was never built; SRDC Year Books, and Minutes of the last Meetings of SRDC. and lots more.

The papers are now all digitised and in due course will be available for viewing on the internet from the NCHRG Website.
